



Off-licence

Sections 17, 19 and 64, Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012

67/OFF/35/2015

PURSUANT to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012, **Akarua Limited**, is authorised to sell alcohol on the premises situated at Rapid 210 Cairnmuir Road, Bannockburn and known as Akarua Winery, to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply alcohol free as a sample for consumption on the premises.

As this licence is not endorsed under section 40 of the Act, the licensee is also entitled to sell alcohol on or from the premises and deliver it to somewhere else.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Subpart 7 of Part 2 of the Act.

Conditions

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- a) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Christmas Day or before 1.00pm on Anzac Day.
- b) No alcohol is to be sold or delivered on Easter Sunday unless the alcohol is grape wine or fruit or vegetable wine made—
 - (i) on the premises; or
 - (ii) from grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated.
- c) Alcohol may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 9.00am to 9.00pm
Remote sales:- At any time on any day
- d) Alcohol may only be delivered Monday to Sunday between the hours of 6.00am and 11.00pm.
- e) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of alcohol to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of alcohol to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- f) Order forms for mail or internet orders must require the buyer and the prospective receiver to declare that they are 18 years of age or over.
- g) A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from the car-park is designated as the principal entrance.

Duration

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force—

- (a) until the close of the period for which it is renewed.or
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made before the licence would otherwise expire until the close of the period 3 years after the period for which it was last renewed.

Expiry date being 23 December 2018 unless renewed for a further period.

Off-Licence

Sections 29 and 114, Sale of Liquor Act 1989

067/OF109/8/2010

PURSUANT to the Sale of Liquor Act 1989, **AKARUA LIMITED**, is authorised to sell or deliver liquor on or from the premises situated at **Rapid 210 Cairnmuir Road, Bannockburn** and known as "**Akarua Winery**", to any person for consumption off the premises and to supply complimentary samples of liquor on the premises.

The authority conferred by this licence must be exercised through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Part 6 of the Act.

CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- a) No liquor is to be sold or delivered on Good Friday, Easter Sunday, Christmas Day or before 1.00 pm on Anzac Day. However, a person may sell or deliver grape wine or fruit wine on Easter Sunday if the grape wine or fruit wine is made –
 - (i) on the premises; or
 - (ii) from grapes or fruit harvested from land on which the premises are situated.
- b) Liquor may be sold or delivered only on the following days and during the following hours:
Monday to Sunday 9.00am to 9.00pm.
- c) The licensee must ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of liquor to prohibited persons are observed and must display appropriate signs adjacent to every point of sale detailing the statutory restrictions on the supply of liquor to minors and the complete prohibition on sales to intoxicated persons.
- d) Order forms for mail or internet orders must require customers to declare that they are 18 years of age or over.

THE LICENSED PREMISES

In terms of Regulation 10 of the Sale of Liquor Regulations 1990 the sale or delivery of liquor is authorised in or from the premises generally including the outside courtyard. The premises located at Rapid 210 Cairnmuir Road, Bannockburn are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by the Central Otago District Licensing Agency on 16 July 2010.

DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE

A copy of this licence must be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from the car-park is designated as the principal entrance.

DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence continues in force -

- (a) Until the close of the period of 1 year commencing with the date of its issue; or
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- (c) If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period for which it is renewed.
