



Sauvignon Blanc 2008

Domain Road Vineyard is a small, specialist producer of outstanding cool climate wines situated in Bannockburn, Central Otago. Established in the heart of a historic gold mining area, the vineyard covers most of a sheltered north-facing valley on the upper terraces above the Kawarau River.

Our Sauvignon Blanc vines are planted partially on the top of Templers Hill, an area left untouched by 19th century Gold Miners and partially on Doctors Flat where mining has exposed mineral rich clays from a two million year old lake bed.

The vineyard is owned by the Crosbie family who have an association of over four decades with the area.

The Wine

Our 2008 Sauvignon Blanc displays typical Sauvignon Blanc aromas of gooseberries, cut grass and bell peppers with citrus undertones.

Approximately one eighth of the wine was fermented in old oak barriques to add a further layer of complexity to the wine.

A hint of residual sugar balances the wine's natural acidity.

Enjoy with seafood, or as an aperitif.
