



QUEENSTOWN SKI AND SNOWBOARD PACKAGE

ITINERARY

Please note: We want to ensure you get the most out of your ski/board days and for this reason our guides will monitor the weather to see what mountain is most appropriate. Please use this itinerary as a guide only.

Day 1 – Saturday

Arrival Day – We will arrange transport for you from the airport

Arrive into Queenstown airport at a time that suits you, and we will arrange transport for you from the airport. You can settle into your accommodation and then depending on your arrival time, you may like to explore the bubbly town or sneak in one of the many activities Queenstown has to offer (Bungy jumping, Jet boating, or perhaps a Gondola ride to take in the views).

Day 2 – Sunday

Please be waiting in the lobby at 7.30am – Coronet Peak (25 minutes)

This morning you will meet your guide who cannot wait to show you the slopes, but firstly we need to pick up rental equipment and a coffee for those who need it. Once we are on the road, it's just a 25 minute drive to Coronet Peak.

Coronet Peak has a ton of awesome rolling terrain to suit anyone and everyone. Whether you are after long intermediate runs, a gentle learner's area or a challenge in the back bowls, Coronet Peak has got it. Your guide will make sure everyone is orientated around the mountain, and skiing or riding the best slopes for them. They can organise any lessons required and they also have a clever ability to time lunch to avoid the crowds!



Day 3 – Monday

*Please be waiting in the lobby at 9.00am
– The Remarkables (40 minutes)*

The Remarkables has a relaxed atmosphere, sun-kissed slopes, and dedicated learning facilities. Your guide will show you how to follow the sun around the resort, by hitting the best slopes at the best times, to get prime conditions! One of New Zealand's biggest terrain parks sits under the chair lift for great entertainment, or perhaps even inspiration!?

Day 4 – Tuesday

Day off snow

Your host gets you sorted no matter what you choose to do, if you want to hit the slopes or experience a heli-ski consider it taken care of. If you want to relax and go your own way that's fine too. There are many sites in Queenstown and check out the many activities available, perhaps even a day trip to the magnificent Milford Sound – what a great way to rest the legs!

Day 5 – Wednesday

*Please be waiting in the lobby at 8.00am
– The Remarkables (40 minutes)*

Today we travel a little further to visit Cardrona Alpine Resort, it's well worth the drive and we have no doubt you will love it there. Cardrona is known for its perfectly groomed runs and vast intermediate level terrain. Of course there are some challenging steps for those who are looking to raise the heart rate, and also a fantastic learners area for those still fine tuning their skills.

Day 6 – Thursday

Please be waiting in the lobby at 8.00am

Day four on snow takes us to the resort with the best weather and snow for the day. Your guide will have studied the weather and snow conditions intently, choosing the best resort for the day. Each resort has different aspects, which affects how much fresh snow they get or how sheltered they are from weather. If it is blue skies and calm weather everywhere, well, you get to choose.
